Extra-Curricular Music Enrolment Support Process

Review of enrolment within Extra Curricular Music programs will follow a three level intervention process.

This three level process will fit within a participation framework including the following criteria:

Academic Performance: Working toward goal setting practices in lessons, monitoring results and developing academic improvement plans for students marked LA or below.

Lesson and Ensemble Attendance: Monitoring lesson and ensemble attendance and following up unexplained absences.

Commitment and Diligence: Completion of assessment at or before the due dates, practicing and progressing at an appropriate level and diligence/behaviour at lessons and rehearsals.

Level 2 Intervention

Academic Intervention: ECCO to contact Parent/Guardian regarding academic performance below an LA.

Intervention Plan: ECCO to formulate a plan with parent/guardian and student regarding academic improvement plan for next assessment period.

Phone Call/Email: ECCO to make contact with Parent or Guardian regarding Three Unexplained Absences from ensembles or lessons. Follow Level 3 intervention for Four Unexplained Absences.

Senior Assessment: Assessment extension will require parent/guardian and HOD approval.

Outstanding Assessment: HOD will make Parent/Guardian made aware of outstanding assessment (from Academic Performance Intervention).

Phone Call/Email: HOD will make contact parent/guardian in the event of repeated lateness or issues regarding organisation.

Head of Department and EC Co-Ordinator contact with Student and Parent/Guardian

Level 3 Intervention

Academic Audit: ECCO to contact parent/guardian to arrange an interview in regards to low academic results.

Review of Enrolment: ECCO and HOD to conduct an enrolment suitability interview and consideration of cancelation of enrolment in extra-curricular music program. Written notification to discontinue from parent/guardian addressed to ECCO.

Review of Enrolment: ECCO and HOD to conduct an enrolment suitability interview and consideration of cancelation of enrolment in extra-curricular music program. Written notification to discontinue from parent/guardian addressed to ECCO.

Non-Completion of Assessment: Letter sent to parent/guardian regarding non-completion of assessment (Senior School). Email notification from Teacher regarding non-completion of assessment to parent/guardian in Middle and Junior Secondary (HOD CC'd).

Review of Enrolment: ECCO and HOD to conduct an enrolment suitability interview and consideration of cancelation of enrolment in extra-curricular music program. Written notification to discontinue from parent/guardian addressed to ECCO.
