Functions of School Council

The school council has the following functions-

- (a) approving plans and policies of a strategic nature and other documents affecting strategic matters, including the annual estimate of revenue and expenditure for the school
- (b) monitoring the school's strategic direction, including selecting a person to participate as a full member on the selection panel appointed to select a principal for the school whenever a vacancy in that office occurs and where the chief executive has determined that a merit selection process is required to fill the vacancy
- (c) monitoring the implementation of the plans, school policies and other documents, mentioned in (a)
- (d) advising the principal about strategic matters
