

Application Process

Student Years 7 – 10

Students self-nominate through a written application process, which will be a common application form for both Junior School and Middle School. A criteria sheet is provided with the application. This application is to be signed off by a teacher.

Applicants are shortlisted by the Year Level Coordinator, the Head of the Sector and the Deputy Principal. Number of leaders are capped at 15 per year level. Should the number of shortlisted applicants be less than this then all the applicants will be offered a position.

Should there be more than 15 applicants, entire cohorts will then vote on their leaders. The voting form will have a statement from each applicant and an image of the student on it. This will be a system where students vote 1st, 2nd and 3rd preference.

The leaders will be assessed against the criteria sheet and selected from there.
